Core changes

1. New Pocketbook x Libby App Added – A new app provides access to public libraries, allowing users to read e-books or listen to audiobooks from their local library. Users can search for a library by name, postcode, or city, filter by country, and either preview content or sign in with a library card to borrow books. Borrowed titles can be read offline in the built-in reader or listened to online, with options to place holds, manage loans, and return books early. The app also provides a shelf for quick access to current books, and an intuitive menu to switch libraries or manage library cards.
2. Accessibility Support Added – The device now includes enhanced accessibility features designed to assist users with visual impairments or reading difficulties, as well as those who wish to personalize their reading comfort. Users can customize the UI text by adjusting Text Size, enabling Bold Text, increasing Grey Text Contrast, and using a Dyslexic Font for improved readability. In addition, Screen Reader mode provides spoken feedback to help users navigate and interact with the device independently and intuitively. These features aim to provide an inclusive and independent reading experience for all users.
3. Added display options for book cover logos (boot and power-off). Users can now choose how the empty space around the book cover is filled — Fill screen, White background (default), Black background, or Depth effect.
4. Updated the system framework to the latest versions to enhance security, reliability, and compatibility with modern technologies.
5. Upgraded the Browser app's web engine to Chrome 122 to deliver a faster, more secure, and smoother web experience, with improved support for modern websites and web technologies.
6. Resolved an issue that prevented some websites from displaying properly in the device browser.

Reading program

1. Fixed cases where marker-based text selection could behave incorrectly in EPUB2 and EPUB3 files. In some cases, highlighting was not possible or inaccurate, could jump or disappear during interaction, expand incorrectly across multiple lines, or fail to select trailing characters at the end of paragraphs.

Other improvements

1. Flac audio format support
2. Improved stability in the Onleihe app when signing in to some libraries.
3. Fixed an issue with the "Save translation as note" setting not being preserved after reboot.
